**NSW SOUTH WALES HIGH POINT AWARDS
REGULATIONS**

Effective as at 1 August 2008

- II To be eligible for Awards, all HORSES, YOUTH or AMATEURS must be nominated in the NSWPHA High Point Awards Scheme.
- II Only NSWPHA Members are eligible to enter and all horses must be registered with the PHAA.
- II Points will be awarded for Shows in NSW and ACT and a maximum of three shows outside of these states per show season, if you do more than three out of state shows you must nominate which shows you would like to be included in the highpoint.
- II Only Shows run by recognised Horse Organisations or Agricultural Societies will be accepted.
- II Champion, Supreme and First Place in a Futurity all receive 1 point (flat), only if 2 or more horses contest the award.
- II Pointscore Sheets must be correctly filled out, stating clearly which section the points are for. Horse, Amateur and Youth Points should be on separate sheets. Name of Show, Membership and Registration Numbers, Judges' name and signature of Judge or Steward must appear on every sheet. (pointscore books are available from the PHAA, a photocopy of this is sufficient)
- II Points Sheets must be received within 30 days of the show - point received over 30 days and up to 60 days will be accepted if accompanied by a \$10 fee.
- II Points from events received after 60 days will not be accepted.
- II Youth cannot compete in or earn points in Amateur Classes.
- II Only Paint Halter classes are eligible for Halter Points.
- II The following Classes are NOT eligible for Points - reserve champion, futurity placings, best marked, best presented etc., beginner classes, pair and costume classes, mixed sex halter classes, single sex ridden classes, other breed classes such as Stock Horse, Pinto, Palomino or Buckskin.
- II Multi judge shows - points will only be accepted from accredited judges ie. HSAA or AQHA registered judges.
- II Agricultural shows - points will only be accepted from "Approved" shows.
- II All shows run by the NSWPHA will attract double points towards the NSW annual highpoint awards, PHAA nationals will attract triple points. All other state shows will attract double points.
- II The NSWPHA committee can at various times, nominate selected other shows that will attract double points for the NSW annual highpoint awards.
- II To win points the Nominated Horse must compete in an event as a 'Paint Horse' and not under a different registration such as Pinto, Buckskin, Stock Horse, Palomino etc.
- II Points will be automatically included for PHAA National and State Shows. For club shows which are PHAA approved please arrange for the points to be forwarded to the NSWPHA highpoint Co-ordinator, or submit your own points for these shows. All other shows you must submit your own points.
- II **HIGH POINT CERTIFICATES** are issued for HIGH POINT and RUNNER UP in ALL Highpoint Categories. (see attached sheet)
