The main point of interest is looking towards the next NSWPHA 2010 State Show. As discussed at the last committee meeting there is a need to plan our show dates at an early stage so that people wishing to attend have plenty of notice, also the Tamworth complex (The Australian Equestrian and Livestock Complex) will be in demand for 2010 by most other western breed horses.

The 2010 NSWPHA State Show will be conducted on the 6th, 7th and 8th May 2010 at the Australian Equestrian and Livestock Complex. There will also be a Paint-O-Rama conducted on Wednesday 4th May. This will assist in attracting competitors to travel from further a field with the opportunity to show under 5 different judges over 4 days of showing. The NSWPHA committee are proposing to acquire two International Judges, both judges to be used to judge the NSWPHA Futurities, whilst one will be engaged to be the main judge at NSWPHA State Show and the other International Judge to judge the Paint-O-Rama alongside two Australian Judges.

The committee will be looking for ways to make your 2010 State Show an enjoyable and exciting experience, planning has already begun. The club is proposing to offer extra incentives in the way of cash which was raised from the initial stallion service sales that Pam Simpson and Sally McPhee conducted. We are looking to offer these incentives in the popular events where everyone has an opportunity to compete. We are always open to suggestions from our members that can make a difference by contributing points of view and certainly with the Tamworth Complex being probably the best complex in Australia to show horses will make a worthwhile show to be involved with. So come and have a look and enjoy the show.

NPHA HIGHLIGHTS

Congratulations and support goes to those NSWPHA members who competed at the 2009 National Pleasure Horse Association Celebration Show. Paints were represented well with some great results and here are some of the highlights from the feature events.

Yearling Halter Futurity – Its Obviously A Ten won this futurity owned by Shanelle Beck shown by Kyle Mobberly, second place went to A Cowboys Tradition owned by Troy Hume and shown by Reece Burchell. Fourth place went to DMB The Investigator owned by Don and Marea Burke of Burkes Stud and shown by Adam O'Connell.

The 2yo & Over Halter Maturity was won by Magnificent Touchdown IMP owned by Smiths Creek Paint Horses and shown by Karen Lonski. Fourth place went to GSQ Shezamyteepieceofart owned by Angie and Bev Chapman shown by Angie Chapman. Certainly these performances in the halter events were very pleasing for the Paints taking it to the other western breeds.

Performance Feature Futurity Events – Yearling Lungeline futurity Glen Geissler and his yearling lungeline entrant Cee The Sensation finished second. \$1500 Amateur Western Pleasure Stakes and the \$1500 Limited Western Pleasure Stakes, Belinda Geissler competing on Barpassinova finished fourth in both events as well as placing fifth in the \$5000 Junior Western Pleasure Derby. It was good to see Belinda's success after her continued commitment to her pleasure horse breeding program.

The big event of the show the \$25,000 2YO Western Pleasure Futurity, paints were represented by Liberation owned by Kathy Sapuppo ridden by Holly Johnson finishing 3rd and Bin Lootin owned by Richard and Cynthia Williams ridden by Ken Davidson placing 6th. Also Liberation received the 2nd place in the 2yo Hunter Under Saddle Futurity whilst Bin Lootin was placed 4th.

Another competitor was ESS J Tunza Gold owned by Melanie Hogan and ridden by Raelene Gilboy who finished 5th in the limited 2yo Western Pleasure and 5th in the 2yo Hunter Under Saddle Futurity. The \$1500 3yo Hunter Under Saddle Futurity went to the well performed Count The Kash owned by William Hupp and ridden by Holly Johnson. Also another credible result Dunuplikadiva owned by J & G Montgomery ridden by Alan Briskey finished 2nd in this event.

As you can see Paints performed very well and made a name for themselves at one of the most prestigious western breed shows held in Australia and we look forward to see these Paints continue on in the future with their success.
